KATAMARAN programme. Aims

- KATAMARAN - ESTABLISHING AND CONDUCTING JOINT SECOND-CYCLE STUDIES
- Specific aims of the Programme include:
 - increasing the number of joint second-cycle studies curricula offered by Polish HEIs
 - increasing mobility of students and academic staff
 - improving the quality of education by implanting international experience at Polish HEIs

KATAMARAN programme. Paths

- **Path A — Establishing the curricula of joint international second-cycle studies and opening enrolment for studies**
- **Path B — Supporting academic mobility under the existing joint international second-cycle studies**

NAWA International Academic Partnerships programme

The objective of the Programme is to develop durable solutions in the area of scientific, implementation and teaching process cooperation, pursued within the framework of international academic partnerships

International Academic Partnerships programme - issues

- drafting of publications with an international scope
- elaboration and lodging of grant applications
- organisation of international conferences, seminars
- participation in internships
- carrying out research and development work with an international dimension
- development of a strategy for dissemination of research
- entering into cooperation with foreign entrepreneurs

Project SilkRoad3D

- „3D Digital Silk Road” (**SilkRoad3D**)
- The aim: establishing joint MSc studies
- Partners:
 - Lublin University of Technology (contractor)
 - 4 universities in Uzbekistan (partners)
- Period: 2019-10-01 → **2021-09-30**
- Budget: ~250 000 EUR

Project SilkRoad3D - aims

- Implementation of scientific and research works in the area of digitization of the Silk Road monuments in Uzbekistan during scientific expeditions by PL in cooperation with partners from Uzbekistan
- Dissemination of research results through international scientific conferences, practical training, monographs and the internet portal www.silkroad3D.com

Project SilkRoad3D

Deliverables (1)

- Four scientific and practical expeditions to the vicinity of 4 partner cities from Central Asia (Samarkand, Tashkent, Urgench, Chirchik) to digitize monuments using 3D scanners
- Data processing, digital preparation of panoramas (5) and 3D models (20) and placing them on the 3D Digital Silk Road internet portal

Project SilkRoad3D

Deliverables (2)

- Organization a scientific conference in Poland to promote project results
- Conducting in Poland two practical training courses on the use of 3D technology in museology for partners
- Preparation of scientific publications for conferences

Project SilkRoad3D

Deliverables (3)

- Publishing of a scientific monograph in Poland
- Update and expansion of the 3D Digital Silk Road internet portal
- Organization a scientific conference in Uzbekistan to promote project results

Project SilkRoad3D

Prerequisites for funding (1)

- Six-years cooperation between Lublin University of Technology and different cultural organisations in Central Asia
- Six agreements with CA universities
- Field of the cooperation: using modern ITC tools to cultural heritage preservation and popularisation - a very important area for modern civilization

Project SilkRoad3D

Prerequisites for funding (2)

- Common activities:
 - Three scientific and research expeditions to the CA
 - Four scientific conferences/seminars
- Cooperation results:
 - 3D scans different objects and monuments in Internet
 - Portal: <http://silkroad3d.com/>
 - Scientific papers: 18
